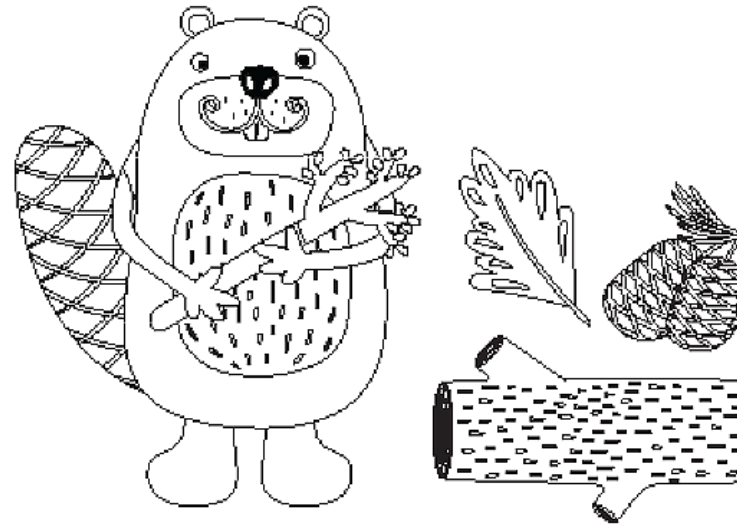

- Yellow-bellied marmots are herbivores and hibernate in burrows during the winter.
- In other parts of the West, yellow-bellied marmots prefer terrain above 6,500 feet. While Bend is much lower than that at 3,623 feet, the yellow-bellied marmots we have here don't seem to mind, and are often spotted happily munching on lawns around town.
- Did you know that rock chucks are considered the Tetherow mascot? During spring and summer, be sure to take a peek outside our windows – you might just see some right here!
